

GRE Updates Effective Fall 2023

Beginning September 22, 2023, the GRE General Test will be shortened from just under 4 hours to just under 2 hours.

Test takers can also expect to receive their scores faster. Along with the decreased exam time, score results will be available within 8-10 days versus the previous 10-15 days' timeframe.

- Additional changes to the GRE include:
- Reduced number of questions in the Quantitative and Verbal Reasoning sections
- Removal of the "Analyze an Argument" task in the Analytical Writing section
- Removal of the unscored section

Beginning September, official GRE test prep resources and practice tests designed for the newer streamlined test will be available. However, because the test is only changing in length and not format, the current prep materials remain efficient.

At this time, there have been no announcements of the exam's fee changing. Test takers will continue to pay \$220 per exam without the GRE Fee Reduction Voucher offered to McNair Scholars.

Feed Your Soul



Gingerbread & Pumpkin Cream Trifle

Ingredients

1 pkg

gingerbread cake mix

1 pkg vanilla pudding mix

1/4 cup packed brown sugar

PServings: 10

TOPS

2/3 canned pumpkin pie mix

1 crt frozen wh

frozen whipped topping, thawed caramel topping,

caramel topping, toasted pecans and gingersnap cookies

Directions

- 1 Prepare and bake gingerbread cake according to package directions. Cool completely on a wire rack
- Meanwhile, prepare pudding mix according to package directions; stir in brown sugar and pie mix. Transfer to a bowl; refrigerate, covered, 30 minutes.
- Cut or break gingerbread into 3/4-in. pieces. In ten 12oz. glasses or a 3-qt. trifle bowl, layer half of each of the following: cake, pumpkin mixture and whipped topping. Repeat layers. Refrigerate, covered, 4 hours or overnight. Top as desired.

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
